-This can be done at any time- But you must do this before you can apply for your pension. You can apply for benefits anytime within 180 days of your retirement date or 180 days before your 65<sup>th</sup> birthday. You can collect your PBGC pension at age 65 even if you are not retired.

IAM National Pension Plan:

You can apply for a pension up to 180 days before your intended pension effective date, but as long as the application is received by your last day of work, you will not be penalized.

   If you are 65 or older at retirement, you will need to contact the Benefits Service Center to have a Medicare and/or Social Security form filled out, to prove that you were covered by an employer sponsored healthcare plan, and weren't required to apply for Medicare Part B. Make sure to get your case number, the name of the representative, and the date and time of your call, for future reference.
   The form should be faxed to 1-847-554-1884, and you should follow-up in 2 business days to check the status of your form. The form will be sent to you via USPS for you to provide to Social Security.
- COBRA: Coverage under COBRA is a continuation of your employee benefit coverage for a limited period. Aon, the COBRA billing administrator, handles solicitation and enrollment. You will receive a COBRA solicitation via mail within three weeks following your retirement.
